The right to education

The right to education

Education in Romania is compulsory from 6 to 15 years old. Children can study in public school or private according to their parent's choice for education.

The right of persons belonging to national minorities to learn their mother tongue, and their right to be educated in this language are guaranteed; The State shall ensure the freedom of religious education, in accordance with the specific requirements of each religious cult. In public schools, religious education is organized and guaranteed by law. (article 32)

Only about 90% of children are educated. Children from poor families are those most likely to be affected by this problem since their parents often prefer them to work rather than study.
